April 16, 2024, Wilmington, DE – Jewish Federation of Delaware has landed 13 winning entries, including six first-place awards, in **Delaware Press Association's 2025 Communications Contest**.

The annual DPA contest is open to all professional communicators in Delaware and nearby out-of-state communities. Judged by out-of-state communications professionals to ensure impartiality, the contest provides an opportunity to compete in various print or electronic broadcasting fields. All DPA contest winners are honored at the DPA Annual Meeting and Contest Awards Banquet each spring.

The annual contest is two-tiered. The first tier of the contest is the statewide DPA competition. The second tier is the national competition, run by the National Federation of Press Women (NFPW). All DPA entries that receive first place are eligible for entry into the national competition.
